II. CATCH Housing First Project: Wyatt Schroeder

• Discussion:

- Funding is coming from low income housing tax credit for the structure costs.
 United Way, City, Hospitals, County, etc. are all chipping in for funding.
- Goal is to have 40 units.
- Concerns about homeless population living near them.
- There is a federal rule preventing individuals on the sex offender list from utilizing the program.
- WAG Opening Date: Break Ground 6 to 8 months, open 18 months out.

III. Heron Hollow/Wylie Boundary Action Item; Splitting Neighborhood

Discussion:

- We just need to amend the bylaws to annex the new part of the neighborhood.
- Instead of splitting into two neighborhood associations, we could create a subdistrict within the neighborhood association.
- West End is a historic part of town, analogous to the East and West Ends
- We are called the Veterans Park Neighborhood because:
 - The state did a study in 1974 to study the impact of the proposed park on the surrounding neighborhoods
 - Quins refused to sell their quarry to the state for the park
 - The people in the neighborhood was never asked if they would like it
 - Then the West End began to suffer because of the connector, which bifurcated the neighborhood.

- Businesses on Fairview and Main were catering to traffic, not to the neighborhood
- Easiest way would be for the West End to Secede from the VPNA.
 - Straw Poll shows a unanimous preference to work toward this option for the neighborhood association.

VII. Whittier Elementary School

Discussion:
