#### I. General Announcements

#### • Discussion:

- F35s: The national guard may put in the F16s if we do not get the F35s, maybe the F22. If that is the case then the noise might be equal; Elaine Clegg informed of the National Guard Mission in Boise. Boise has not had training missions for deployment. The F35 mission would be to get the pilots familiarized with the airplanes. The City has asked to have the F35s in for a test, but it is the State of Idaho that has the lobbyist to advocate for project here. There is no need to develop Gowen Field for a 3<sup>rd</sup> runway. The City is looking to build Gowen Road up to freight standards.
- Rae went to an All Neighborhood Association meeting to discuss ways for the neighborhood associations to band together to increase the power collectively.
- Concerns about the weeds at the former Salvation Army lot; syringes found on the lot.
- Boise Bike Boulevard update: group is submitting ideas for Bike Boulevards to ACHD. One of the ideas is to identify a way to get from Lowell School area across State Street without using a major north-south street. The idea is to create a thoroughfare across the end of Woodlawn west of 27<sup>th</sup> street. ACHD meeting is July 10<sup>th</sup>.
